PLEASE REVIEW THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR CHILD.

FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS:

If your child will be bringing any **prescription or over-the-counter medications** (even Tylenol or Advil), please accompany your child into the GW band room prior to departure on Friday morning, May 14, and give the medications to the school nurse on site. All medications are to be sealed in a "Ziploc" style bag and clearly labeled with you child's name and dosing instructions.

Because we have approximately 75 students participating in this competition, it is essential that all students comply fully with the *GWMS*Band Code of Conduct. If, for any reason, a student's behavior is unacceptable at the discretion of the band directors, parents/guardians will be contacted by phone and will be expected to drive to Williamsburg to pick up their child, regardless of the hour.

All students participating in the trip are required to ride the bus to and from Williamsburg. Parents may <u>NOT</u> pick up their children from Busch Gardens.

WHAT TO BRING:

Band Items:

- Instrument (name tag, provided prior to departure)
- Instrument accessories (cleaning items, oil, slide grease, reeds, etc.)
- Music folder

Full uniform:

Symphonic Band: white dress shirt that buttons to collar, black socks, black shoes, garment bag with GW band uniform.

Jazz Band: black collared Jazz band shirt, black dress pants or black jeans, socks, black shoes, garment bag with GW band uniform.

Hotel Items & Clothing:

- Students are to adhere to the GWMS dress code. **Students will** not be allowed on the bus wearing pajamas.
- Luggage, one medium sized piece (name tag provided prior to departure)
- Appropriate sleepwear for Friday night.
- **Appropriate** swimwear & beach towel (or large bath towel).
- Clothes for Busch Gardens on Saturday.
- Personal items/toiletries (toothbrush, soap, hairdryer, deodorant, etc.)
- Any required medications to be given to school nurse prior to departure.

Park Items:

- Wristwatch
- Sunblock
- Comfortable shoes
- GWMS Band tee-shirt (to be given out on-site)
- Camera (preferably small and disposable)
- Lightweight jacket in case of cool weather
- Money: Friday pre performance stop at the Virginia Center Commons Mall in Glen Allen for snack/lunch, Saturday dinner/snacks and souvenirs at Busch Gardens. \$25-\$50 recommended.

WHAT **NOT** TO BRING:

Boombox – VCR or DVD player – Xbox/PS2-3 – multiple CDs/DVDs – stuffed animals – more than one medium sized piece of luggage – anything that violates ACPS policy (pocketknives, tobacco, alcohol, drugs, etc.).

Excessive candy/sweets & caffeine drinks will be confiscated by the band director.

You may bring personal listening devices (iPods, etc) at your own risk. The band is not responsible for loss of any items.

ITINERARY

DAY ONE: Friday, May 14, 2010

8:30 a.m. Students meet in the Band Room for trip briefing, label and pack instruments and uniforms for loading on motorcoaches.

9:30 a.m. Motorcoaches arrive ready for loading. Students are grouped by grade level on two deluxe motorcoaches.

10:30 a.m. Depart from GWMS aboard a deluxe, restroom-equipped motorcoach.

12:00 p.m. En route, enjoy lunch at individual expense in the food court at the Virginia Center Commons Mall. (VA Center Commons Mall: 10102 Brook Rd., Glen Allen, VA 23059; (804) 266-9000; from 95 S – exit 86B onto Route 1, Brook Rd., Glen Allen, VA.)

1:00 p.m. Depart lunch stop for Williamsburg.

2:30 p.m. Arrive at the *George Washington Inn & Conference Center* located at 500 Merrimac Trail, Williamsburg, VA 23158 and **check in** (800-804-6835). Change into band uniforms.

4:00 p.m. Depart the hotel for *Bruton High School*. (Bruton HS: 185 East Rochumbeau Dr. , Williamsburg, 757-220-4050)

4:50 p.m. Symphonic Band warm-up.

5:15 p.m. Symphonic Band plays.

6:00 p.m. Depart for Berkeley Middle School. (Jazz band eats box meal en route.)

6:30 p.m. Jazz Band warm-up. Symphonic Band eats box meal.

6:55 p.m. Jazz Band plays.

7:30 p.m. Depart for hotel

8:00 p.m. Arrive at the hotel; check into rooms and get settled.

8:30-10:00 p.m. Pool time. Bring your own towel. THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY; GROUP MEMBERS SWIM AT THEIR OWN RISK; GWMS CHAPERONES WILL BE SUPERVISING THE POOL.

Students will be either in the pool area or in their rooms. There is no wandering around the hotel or outside of the building.

10:00 p.m. Students return to rooms. Pizza delivery.

10:30 p.m. Room check and lock down. Students must be in their assigned rooms at this time.

11:00 p.m. Lights out, TV off. There is a noise ordinance in Williamsburg!

DAY TWO: Saturday, May 15, 2010

7:00 a.m. Wake up. Clean room, pack, wait to be called to breakfast.

8:00 a.m. Enjoy a buffet breakfast at the hotel. Students will be sent to breakfast in groups of 20-30 for seating reasons.

9:30 a.m. Check out from the hotel and board motorcoaches. Students will be dismissed from their respective rooms after an acceptable room inspection by a chaperone.

Students must wear their GWMS band tee-shirts on Saturday to *Busch Gardens*.

10:00 a.m. Arrive at *Busch Gardens*. Enjoy the park! Meals throughout the day are available from a variety of moderately priced eateries and are at individual expense.

1:00 p.m. Check in with the Band Director/Chaperones at the Mist Bridge into Ireland.

4:15 p.m. Check in with the Band Director/Chaperones outside the Royal Palace Theatre for the *Music in the Parks* competition results.

5:00 p.m Awards Ceremony at the Royal Palace Theater

5:30 p.m. Last chance for shopping/eating.

6:30 p.m. Board motorcoaches for the return trip. **Students MUST return to GWMS on the motorcoach.**

9:30 p.m. Arrive at *George Washington Middle School*, Alexandria. Arrival time is approximate and depends on weather and traffic.

Dear Band Parents and Students:

We are beginning our preparations for the annual Spring Band Trip. This year, the GWMS Symphonic and Jazz Bands (approximately 75 students) will be competing in the Music in the Parks Festival at Busch Gardens, Williamsburg, Virginia on May 14-15th. The actual per student cost will be approximately \$200 which will be offset by each students fundraising balance; the final cost for each student will depend on the success of each individual student's fundraising. Future opportunities to offset the cost will be available through the annual Spring fundraisers. The total cost will include round-trip transportation aboard deluxe motor coaches, accommodations for one night, selected meals, GWMS Band t-shirts, festival fees, and admission to Busch Gardens. Based on the fall popcorn fundraiser and any amounts left over from last year's fundraising activity, your current account balance is:

Student: Account Balance:

At this point, we are asking for the following if your student plans to attend the trip:

\$50.00 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit to secure your child's reservation Permission Slip to be signed by parent/guardian <u>and</u> student. (Enclosure #1) Health Form – *Required by ACPS for all participants* (Enclosure #3)

It is very important to fill out the Health Form completely. To ensure the safety of all participants, all student medications (including over-the-counter medications) must be given to the designated chaperone on the morning of departure from school on May 14th. The chaperone will be responsible for ensuring medications are taken on schedule, and in the proper amount. The only exception is inhalers, which students are permitted to keep in their possession. If there are any privacy concerns about the information contained on your child's Health Form, please place it in a sealed envelope before delivering to school. The only individuals with access to information on these forms are the band directors and one assigned chaperone (the School Nurse generally): all are required to comply with Federal health information privacy regulations.

More detailed information will be forthcoming as we finalize our plans.

Please read the GWMS Band Code of Conduct (Enclosure #2) and discuss it with your child. Fill in and sign the Permission Slip, parent/guardian and student signatures are required. Return the signed Permission Slip and completed Health Form with your non-refundable \$50.00 check payable to *GWMS Band Boosters*, to the band directors in advance of January 29th.
